Point of tourist interest to discover

Le PONT DU GARD, one of the few sites to be labeled both “UNESCO World Heritage” and Grand site of France”

- The roman aqueduct (possibility to swim : equipped beaches)
- The museum about roman history.
- The « Mémoires de Garrigue » : outdoor trail to discover agriculture...
- The ludo : museum space for the children.
- Exhibitions and 7 km of marked trail with picnic areas.

NIMES, Nemausus

- The amphitheater (open from 9 a.m to 8 p.m.)
- The “Maison Carrée” (open from 10 a.m to 8 p.m)
- The « Tour Magne » (open from 9 a.m to 8 p.m). Prices for this monuments: 11.70 € and 9.5€
- The « Jardins de la Fontaine », the « temple de Diane », the « Castellum » (free)
- The church and cathedral

UZES, first Duchy of France, city of Art and History

- The center of the village, the « place aux herbes » (market : Wednesday and Saturday morning)
- The ducal castle (Renaissance), open from 9 to 12h.30 a.m and from 2 to 6 p.m. full tour of the castle: 18€/adult, 14€ (child from 12 to 16 years), 7€ (child from 7 to 11 years) free – of 7 years.
- Haribo sweet museum : open from 10 a.m to 7p.m. Prices : 7€/adult, 4.50€/child (5 to 15 years)

LA ROQUE-SUR-CEZE, ranked among the most beautiful villages of France

- The center of the village and its point of view over the “Cascades du Sautadet”
- The remains of the castle and the roman chapel
- The « Cascades du Sautadet »
